If you are not familiar with WATTS, we have been providing safe, temporary, overnight cold-weather shelter to individuals experiencing homelessness in Winchester, Frederick County, and Clarke County since 2009. Our Overnight Shelter operates from November through March and is made possible through partnerships with churches and community organizations that host our guests for one week at a time, opening their facilities.

More than 3,000 volunteers each season help provide warm dinners, breakfasts, basic necessities, fellowship, and compassionate care. In response to growing community needs, WATTS expanded its services to include a daytime Warming Center during the winter months. Additionally, our knowledgeable, highly trained, and compassionate Transition Support Specialists work year-round to help guests navigate barriers, access resources, and move toward stable housing. This summer, our Support Specialists also began meeting with guests in a dedicated office space, allowing services to continue throughout the shelter's off-season.

Every day, your support helps make our mission of **breaking the cycle of homelessness, one life at a time** a reality. WATTS is truly a remarkable community effort, and each year we are humbled by the generosity and compassion of individuals, churches, businesses, foundations, and community organizations that make our work possible. Your partnership allows us not only to continue serving our neighbors in need, but also to expand our impact and reach even more people experiencing homelessness.
